### Become a Touch Bearer – Choose Your Commitment

#### ◆ 1. Life Partnership

**Definition:** A covenant commitment to support The Lighter Ministry financially with no end date in view.

**Explanation:**

This type of partnership is for individuals who feel divinely connected to the long-term vision of the ministry. It represents a lifelong pledge to continually support the Gospel’s advancement through regular financial contributions — whether monthly, quarterly, or yearly — for as long as the Lord enables.

**Ideal for:** Kingdom-minded individuals and families who see themselves as legacy builders in evangelism.

#### ◆ 2. Ongoing Partnership

**Definition:** A recurring monthly donation with the flexibility to pause or stop at any time.

**Explanation:**

This partnership offers consistency and convenience for partners who want to support monthly but prefer to retain control over the length of their commitment. It allows for manageable giving while providing the ministry with a steady source of support.

**Ideal for:** Supporters with a heart for regular giving but variable circumstances.



### ◆ 3. Fixed-Term Partnership

**Definition:** A commitment to give monthly for a set duration — 3, 6, 9, or 12 months.

**Explanation:**

This structured partnership is perfect for donors who want to commit for a specific season. It's great for budgeting and allows partners to review and possibly renew their commitment after their chosen term ends.

**Ideal for:** New partners, short-term supporters, or those led to give during a particular season of ministry focus.

### ◆ 4. Project-Based Partnership

**Definition:** Giving towards a specific campaign, crusade, or project.

**Explanation:**

Partners contribute a one-time or periodic donation designated for a specific need — e.g., a citywide crusade, media outreach, or construction of a prayer city. Donors can clearly see the impact of their giving and often feel more connected to tangible results.

**Ideal for:** Individuals, churches, or businesses that prefer to give towards clearly defined goals or projects.

### ◆ 5. Seed-Faith Partnership

**Definition:** One-time giving based on a personal faith expectation or breakthrough.

**Explanation:**

Inspired by moments of divine instruction or personal need, this giving is often sacrificial and prophetic. It reflects the giver's faith that God will multiply the seed sown — spiritually and practically.

**Ideal for:** Believers who are moved during special services, fasts, or as led by the Spirit.

### ◆ 6. Corporate or Church Partnership

**Definition:** Churches, ministries, or businesses that adopt The Lighter Ministry as a mission partner.

**Explanation:**

This partnership allows larger groups or organizations to regularly support TLM as part of their outreach or kingdom budget. It may involve financial donations, mobilizing volunteers, or hosting revival events.

**Ideal for:** Churches with mission budgets or Christian-led businesses wanting to sow into global evangelism.

### ◆ 7. In-Kind Partnership

**Definition:** Giving of resources, services, or time rather than direct financial donations.

**Explanation:**



Some individuals or organizations may choose to partner by offering professional services, equipment, media, printing, logistics, or volunteering.

**Ideal for:** People with valuable skills or resources that can support the ministry operationally.

#### ◆ 8. Youth or Student Partnership

**Definition:** Low-threshold giving model for young people or students.

**Explanation:**

Encourages youth to give consistently, even in small amounts (e.g., £5/month), fostering a heart of generosity and building a future culture of mission-focused support.

**Ideal for:** Emerging leaders and future evangelists who may not yet afford large donations but want to be involved.
